

Grant Funding Sources

Federal Grants

- <u>Grant.gov</u> The main hub for federal grants. You can search, apply, and track funding opportunities.
- <u>SAM.gov</u> The System for Award Management lists federal assistance programs and contract opportunities.
- <u>HUD.gov</u> Grants for community development, housing assistance, and urban improvement.
- rd.usda.gov Funding for rural infrastructure, utilities, and business support.
- EDA.gov Grants for economic growth, innovation, and infrastructure.
- <u>FEMA.gov</u> Funding for disaster preparedness, mitigation, and response programs.
- <u>Transportation.gov</u> Grants for road improvements, public transit, and infrastructure.
- <u>EDA.gov</u> Grants for economic development, job creation, and regional planning.

State Grants

- State Environmental Agencies Funding for water infrastructure, energy efficiency, and climate resilience projects.
- State Housing Finance Agencies Grants for affordable housing, homelessness prevention, and community revitalization.
- State Emergency Management Agencies Disaster preparedness and mitigation funding.
